**ENGLISH**

Graduates of a BC/Yukon Secondary School with a blended grade of 80% or lower in English 12 **MUST** write the English Diagnostic Test. Students with a blended grade of 81% or higher in English 12 will be able to register in ENGL 110.

All other students admitted without first-year credit for English at a post-secondary institution will be required to write the diagnostic test in order to determine into which English course they will register: ENGL 099 or 110.

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**MATHEMATICS – ONLY Students interested in pursuing majors in Science or Business**

All other admitted students will be required to write the diagnostic tests in order to determine into which of the three Mathematics courses for Science or Business majors they will enter: MATH 098, 099 or 110.
