Faculty Appointment in Business and Economics

Corpus Christi College invites applications for a three-year faculty position in Business and Economics at the rank of Assistant Professor (non-tenure track). This position is designed as a 3 year appointment, and will begin on September 1, 2019. Corpus Christi College does not have a tenure system, but candidates who successfully complete their three year term will be considered for an ongoing appointment.

We seek an outstanding and enthusiastic teacher and scholar with a demonstrated excellence in teaching and learning in order to prepare and teach undergraduate courses in Business and Economics, including our growing Associate of Arts degree program. This is an open field competition, and successful candidate will be expected to demonstrate an ability to teach first and second year Business and Economics courses in their field of expertise. The successful candidate will carry a teaching load of up to six [6] courses, and will be expected to perform service and administrative responsibilities in support of the College.

Candidates must have at least a Master's degree with a combination of industry experience in a related field. A doctoral degree in a related field is preferred. At Corpus Christi College, we believe that good research informs good teaching. As such, successful candidates will be expected to maintain an active research profile that is appropriate to the teaching and service loads of the college.
