Corpus offers all the admission requirement courses for you to apply to programs such as the UBC Bachelor of Science in Nursing with up to 48 non-nursing university credits.

The Showbiz program offers students the ability to take core Business courses while also continuing in their creative arts passions.

Students can study Marketing, Organizational Behaviour, Business Communications, Social Media Strategy, and Economics, and grow in skills that will help them in the marketplace and in the “business of art” in the film industry.

Likewise, students can take courses in Theatre, Film, Creative Writing, Journalism, Bard on the Beach, Screenwriting, Acting, and Film Production where they will build upon other courses and apply skills in project management, digital media usability, storyboarding, marketing, and fundraising while completing creative projects.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FROM COUNSELLORS

WHERE ARE YOU LOCATED?

The UBC Vancouver campus. We have been on the UBC campus for over 60 years.

IS CORPUS CHRISTI TUITION EXPENSIVE?

No. We are a non-profit institution and we work hard to keep our tuition low so students can access affordable education. Our tuition rates are competitive with the larger public universities in BC.

ARE CORPUS CHRISTI COURSES TRANSFERABLE?

Yes. All Corpus Christi courses are transferable to UBC and many courses are transferable to other institutions.

ARE SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE?

Yes. We have a range of scholarships based on academics, volunteering, and service. Students can receive automatic grade-based awards. Our largest scholarship is valued at \$25,000.

DO YOU HAVE TO BE CATHOLIC OR CHRISTIAN TO ATTEND CORPUS CHRISTI?

No. Our students have a variety of religious backgrounds. Corpus Christi is proud of its Catholic identity and mission, which includes dialogue and collaboration. We have a Campus Ministry team and Corpus students can engage with the UBC Multi-Faith Chaplains who provide resources for students of many religions including Muslim, Sikh, Jewish, Buddhist and more.

CAN STUDENTS ONLY TRANSFER TO UBC AFTER LEAVING CORPUS CHRISTI?

No. Our students have successfully transferred to UBC, McGill, Queen's, University of Toronto, Simon Fraser University, University of Victoria, Emily Carr University, Bishop's University, Carleton University, Saint Francis Xavier, La Sorbonne (France), Osaka University (Japan), and others.

WHAT IS CORPUS CHRISTI'S CONNECTION TO UBC?

Full-time Corpus Christi College students can access many of the services and benefits UBC offers its students. They are eligible to opt into AMS Health and Dental coverage, receive a UBC Library Card and Compass Card transit pass, and join UBC intramurals and clubs. They can access UBC facilities like the Student Union Building and Aquatic Centre, as well as UBC's Student Services like Student Health and Counselling, and the Centre for Accessibility.

ARE STUDENTS REQUIRED TO TAKE RELIGION COURSES?

No. As part of a Liberal Arts education, we encourage students to learn more about religion, history, philosophy and literature. Courses such as World Religions are not required courses, but are very popular with our students.

Students continue into programs in Business, Arts, Science, Teaching, Nursing and more.
